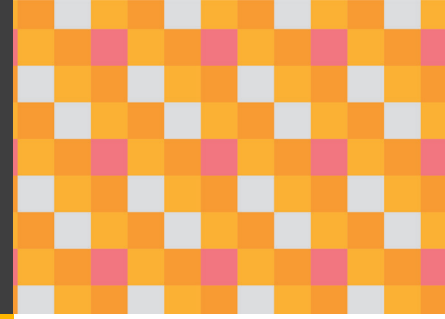

PwC application requirements:

- Must be a Namibian Citizen, certified copy of ID to be included;
- Overall 65% average with Mathematics, Accounting and English on higher level in grade 11, and in grade 12 we expect a 2 rating for these subjects. If you have these subjects on Extended level an A* is required;
- Curriculum Vitae to be included;
- Two written references are to be included. One from inside the school and one from outside of school excluding a family member;
- Applicants have to include latest academic results;
- Applicants have to submit an essay of approximately 300 words on what the characteristics are that make you the most suitable candidate for awarding a bursary to;
- Other requirements include proficiency in English, good communication skills, logical thinking to solve problems, working knowledge of technology, good social skills, and be able to work well in a team;
- Students who obtained a bursary from another financial institution that requires the student to complete work after studies, will not qualify for a PwC bursary.

Process:

- Shortlisted candidates will be subject to a personality and aptitude test;
- Formal and informal interviews will be held;
- Candidates will be notified via email if their application is successful or unsuccessful.
